
Harlequin Acorns is a fabulous way to introduce your child to the love of dance.

Fees:

Single Class Fee	£4.50	For classes booked and paid singularly.
Acorn / Primary 10 Class Bundle	£40.00	For a credit of 10 classes to be used as required. Live for 6 weeks from purchase date and can be used for sibling bookings in Acorn classes.
Acorn Pass	£90.00	Credit for 5 classes per week / 30 per half term

Age Groups Explained:

Children can start classes at Harlequin Stage School in ballet and Acrobatic arts at 2yrs. [Baby classes].

The academic school year before children go to school they enter Pre School classes and can attend ballet, modern and Acrobatic Arts. [Pre School Classes].

The academic school year that children attend school in reception they enter Reception classes and can attend ballet, modern tap and Acrobatic Arts. [Reception Classes].

When students reach Year 1 + they can attend Pink Bubble classes in ballet, modern, tap, acrobatic arts, musical theatre, Stretching & limbering and jazz.

Exams:

At the end of each Christmas term all Acorn students are invited to take their medal tests in ballet and modern. Teachers enter into the studio with the students in this exam.

Pre School - Bronze

Reception - Silver

Year 1 - Gold

Year 2 – Prelim Primary

These examinations are internal and give all students a great sense of achievement as they are awarded with a medal and certificate; parents are given some written feedback on a report and a graded result gives an indication as to how your son/daughter is progressing.

When each pupil is ready [this usually starts when children are Year 2+] they will be entered for external examinations where pupils need to learn a set syllabus and are examined by an external examiner. The students enter the exam room in specific sets and are not accompanied by a teacher. Teachers at Harlequin Stage School are qualified to enter students into external examinations with BBO dance, Royal Academy of Dance, Imperial Society of Teachers of Dance and Acrobatic Arts.

Frequently asked Questions:

When do I need to purchase uniform?

Uniform is not necessary for the first few weeks of joining Harlequin Acorns. Shorts and a t shirt and bare feet are fine for the first half term.

What arrangements have been made to facilitate COVID guidelines?

Students Year 1 and above are greeted and registered in at the door and taken to a changing area where a student teacher is there to assist, prior to the class time the students are taken down to line up outside the studio door with the student teacher. When the class finishes students are returned to their changing room with their student teacher and either helped to prepare for the next class or taken out to Reception where they are reunited with their parent/carer.

Students Reception and below: parents are permitted into the building and must wait in the allocated changing room where social distancing must be adhered to and mask must be worn by parents. Students will be returned to the waiting parents following the class by the student teachers.

All barres, door handles and props will be satirised fully after use. Students will be encouraged to sanitise hands prior to entering and leaving class, hand holding will be discouraged. Classes sizes are limited as per COVID risk assessment advice for the room dimensions and ventilation.

Do I send a drink into class?

You can send drinks if students are participating in more than one class. Drinking on demand will not be encouraged throughout a 30 min class. Please ensure all drinks bottles are clearly named.

Can my son / daughter dance just for a hobby?

Of course, enjoyment and participation is the greatest part of dance classes, students are encouraged to explore their imagination and creativity. Shows are held regularly (where COVID allows!) where everyone that wants to take part can do so and we hold medal tests annually for all Pre School - Year 2 students in Ballet, modern, tap and Acrobatics Arts.

How does my son / daughter progress through Harlequin Stage School? All students move up each year in the same way as their academic school year. Usually around Year 2/3 Harlequin Acorns are progressed through into the Junior part of the school and will enter the external examinations, We hold 2 external ballet examinations sessions per year and one modern, tap and Acrobatic Arts. Students are entered when Miss Paula and team feel they have reached their full potential in that grade. Should any student decide they do not wish to take examinations no child is held back – they would simply move to the next grade with the rest of the class.

Do I pay for weeks we can't attend?

it is advisable to book online in advance as if the class is full - due to COVID regulations we cannot go over that number. If you can't attend, you can advise Harlequin reception and they could look to see if there is a suitable alternative class

you can be swapped onto during that same week but refunds will not be given and booked classes cannot be moved to the following week. Expired bundles cannot be reimbursed - a bundle consists of a 10-class bundle and needs to be used in a 6 week period. Passes are valid for a 6-week half term period.

What is the difference in classes?

Ballet is the basis of all dance disciplines. Harlequin Acorns is a wonderful introduction into the magical world of classical ballet for boys and girls from 2 years. Ballet is fun and creative and encourages children to express themselves through dance, music and imagination.

Modern is an excellent tool for developing confidence, self esteem, group concept and personal progress. Music used is usually upbeat and familiar to the students.

Acrobatic Arts is a unique blend of dance and gymnastic disciplines. Stunning moves from gymnastics are blended with steps and routines for a unique and modern approach to dance. Acrobatic Arts focusses on balance, limbering, tumbling, flexibility and strength – all based around the classical technique. This class is great to improve strength and flexibility and to learn a progressive syllabus that will enable safe tricks and tumbling.

Tap dance classes are fun. They involve creating sounds and rhythms with the feet. Tap is good for the brain.

Musical Theatre is singing, movement and drama. Students grow in confidence whilst learning basic singing techniques, presentation and projection, drama games and monologues.

Jazz is a fun class where different styles of dance are explored and new steps are introduced and perfected. Jazz classes should be attended in conjunction with limbering and stretching.

Limbering and Stretching is a class where all the muscles are stretched and warm ready for the jazz class that follows. Students are taught haw to warm up their bodies and how to understand how their bodies work in dance.
